

# Instructions for Requesting Access to NRI Applications

Note: You must have an NRI Account before you can request access to NRI Applications. If you do not have an NRI Account, please navigate to <https://www.nrisurvey.org/accountManager/> and follow the instructions to **Create an NRI Account** before proceeding.

1. Open your internet browser and navigate to <https://www.nrisurvey.org/accountManager/>.
2. Enter your NRI Account **username** and **password** on the Log In page and click the **Log In** button.

4. The resulting page will show a list of the available applications that utilize the NRI Account system. To request access to an application, **find the name of the desired application** on the left side of the screen. In the dropdown to the right of the desired application, **select the location** in which you work and then click on the **Request Access** button directly to the right. Note: if you have already requested access to a given application, the option may be disabled and have a note next to it such as *(requested already)*.

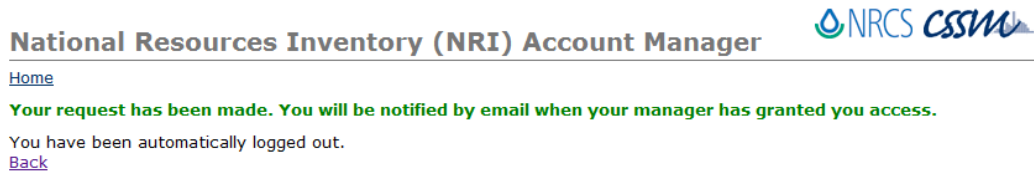
### Request Application Access

To request access to an application, please choose the location that you will be working in. Once you request access, a manager will have to approve your request before you can access the application. You will receive an email when your request is approved.

5. Once your request has been made, you will receive the confirmation page below. At this point, you still **do not have access** to the requested application.



6. A manager will receive your request to access the application. Once the manager approves your request, you will receive a confirmation email similar to the one below. **Once you receive the approval email, you will be able to log in to the requested application using your NRI Account.** *Note: you will also receive an email if the manager denies your request. The most common cause of this is that you inadvertently requested access to the wrong application or from the wrong location. If this occurs, you will need to submit a new request with the appropriate selections.*
